## **Garbage Disposal**

Residents, please to be sure to break down larger items, boxes, etc. before disposal. Please do not place refuse in full recycling bins. Miller Waste has regular pickups scheduled for Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday over the holidays- please use your discretion during this week.

## **Christmas Trees**

Please be reminded that although live Christmas trees are permitted in the building, **the tree must be transported in a polyethylene (plastic) tree bag** to avoid creating a mess in the common areas. This applies when both bringing in and disposing of your tree.

## Tree Disposal

Live trees should be placed at the curb of Radom Street for disposal on either the weeks of January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020 or January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020. If residents do not take advantage of these pickup times, they will be responsible for taking their own trees to a recycling depot.

## **Fire Safety**

Residents are reminded to exercise common practice during the holiday season with regard to fire safety.

- Do not overload electrical circuits with Christmas lights.
- Do not place electrical cords in traffic areas, under mats or carpets.
- Keep live trees well-watered so they do not dry out and create a fire hazard.
- Ensure your unit is equipped with a working smoke detector(s)
